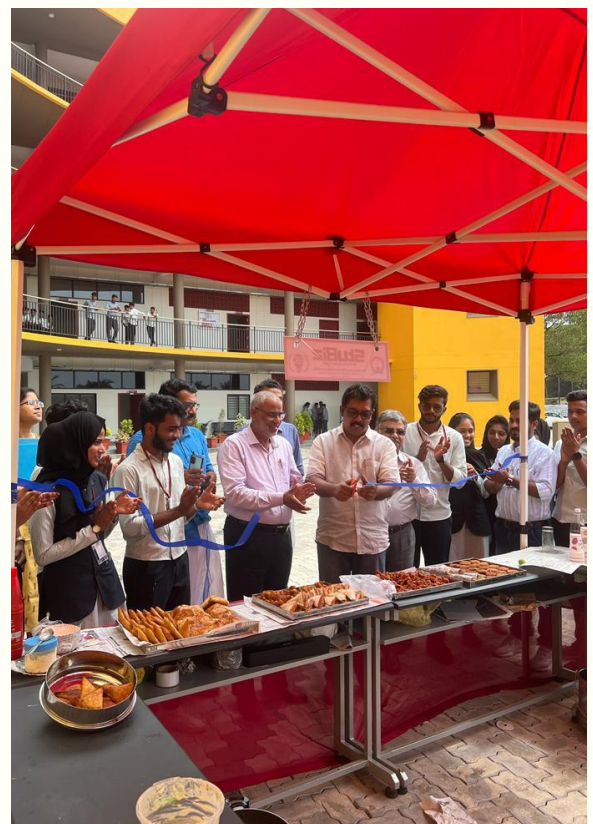

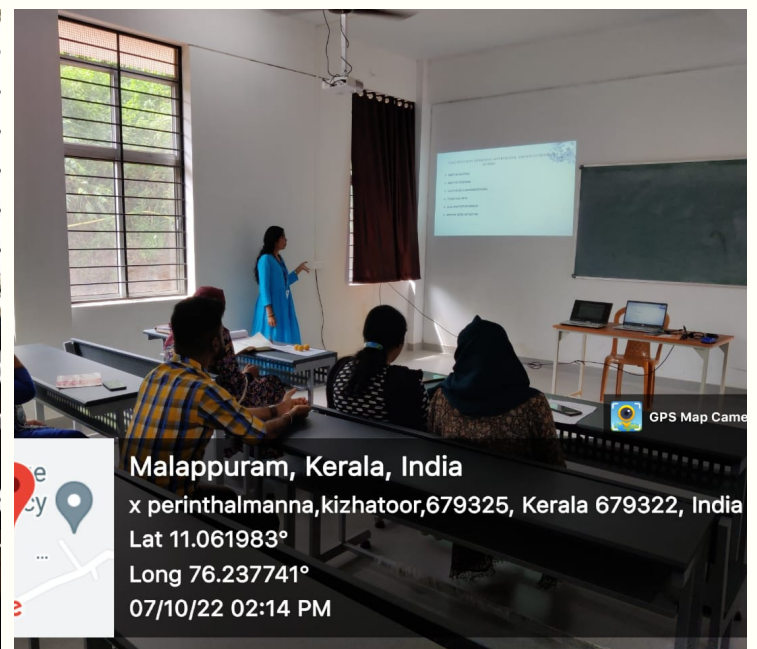
Public Transport Day

Research Article Review Sessions



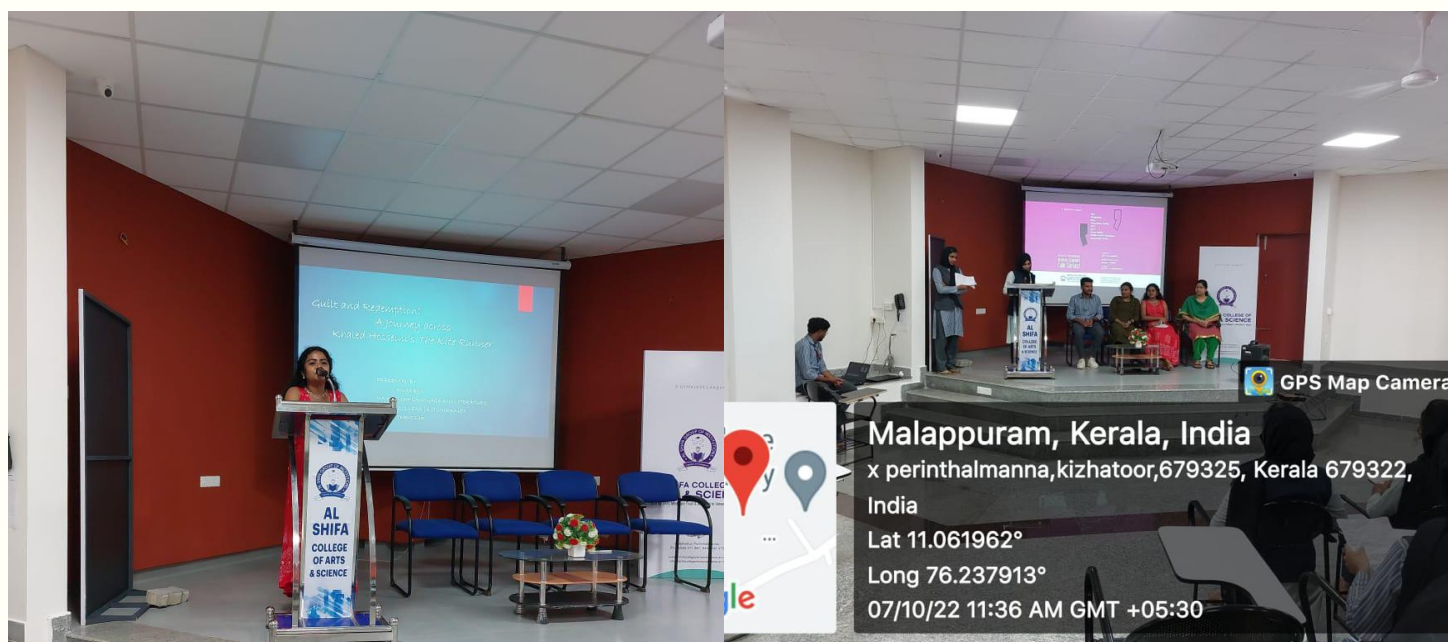

Invited Student Talk Series

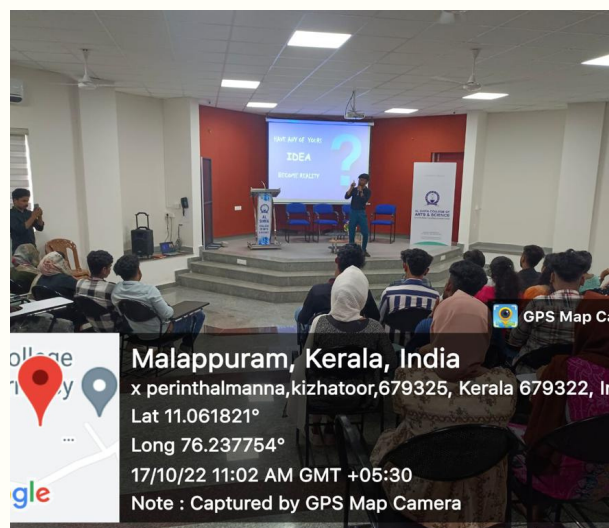
Department of English

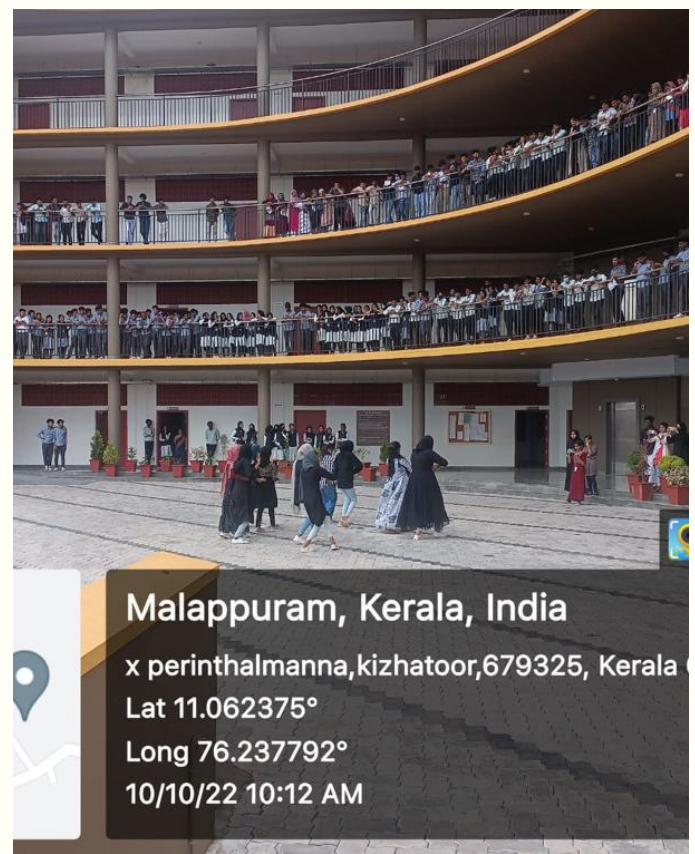
University B-Zone Championship

Session on Animal Studies

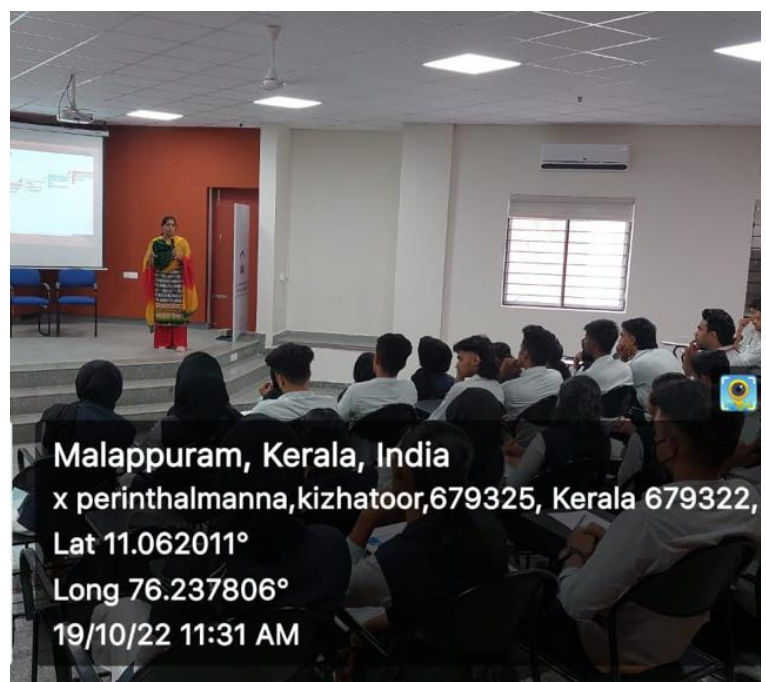

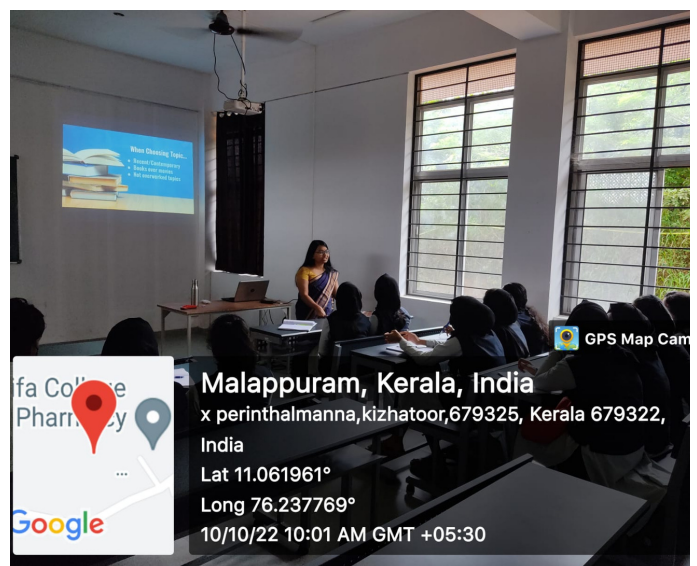
Department of Economics

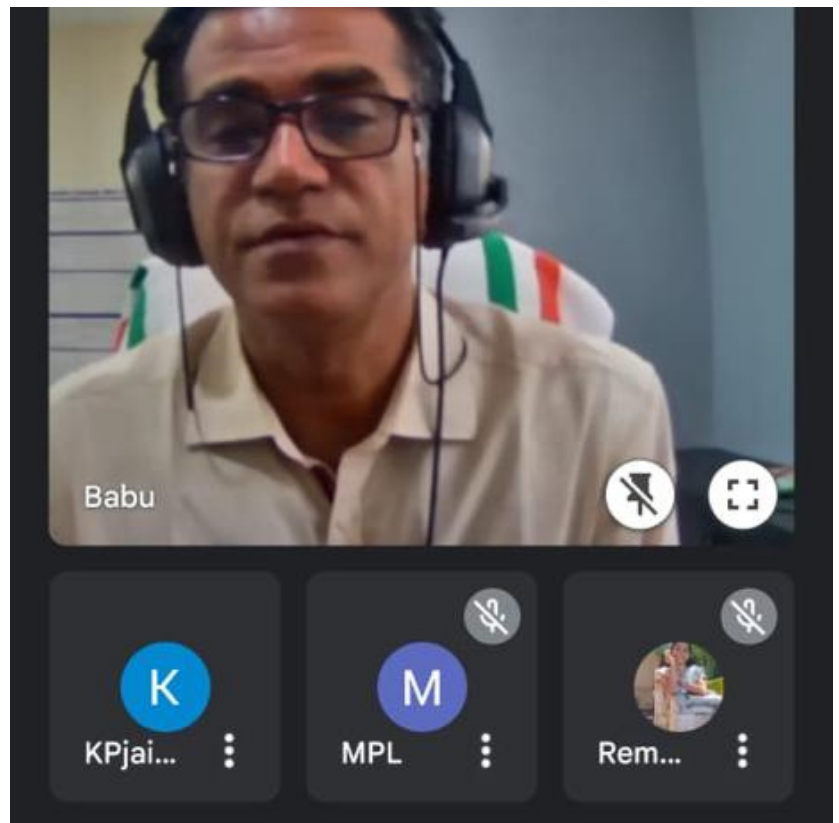
Session on Civil Service
