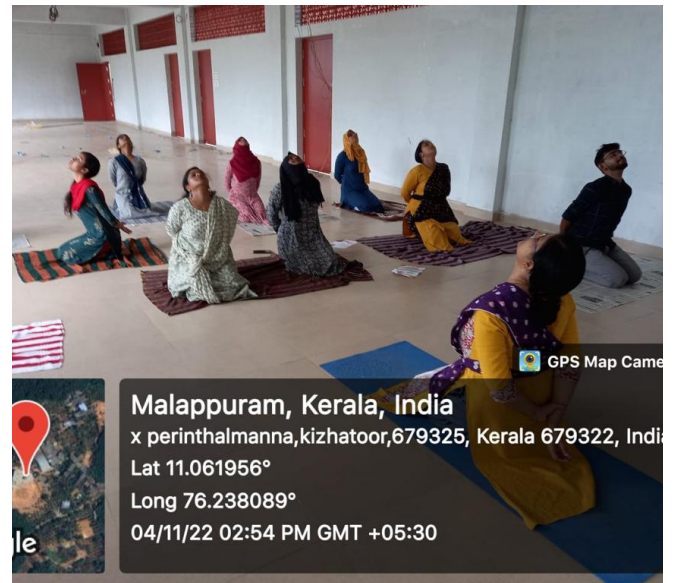
## Centre for Professional Studies

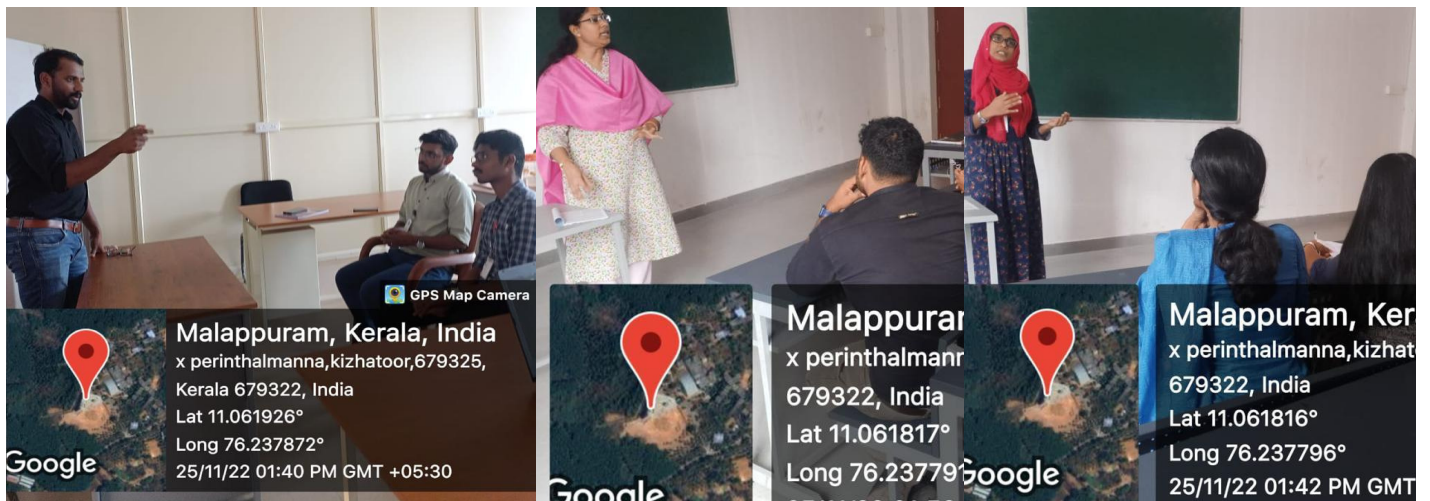


## **Art Fest at ACAS**

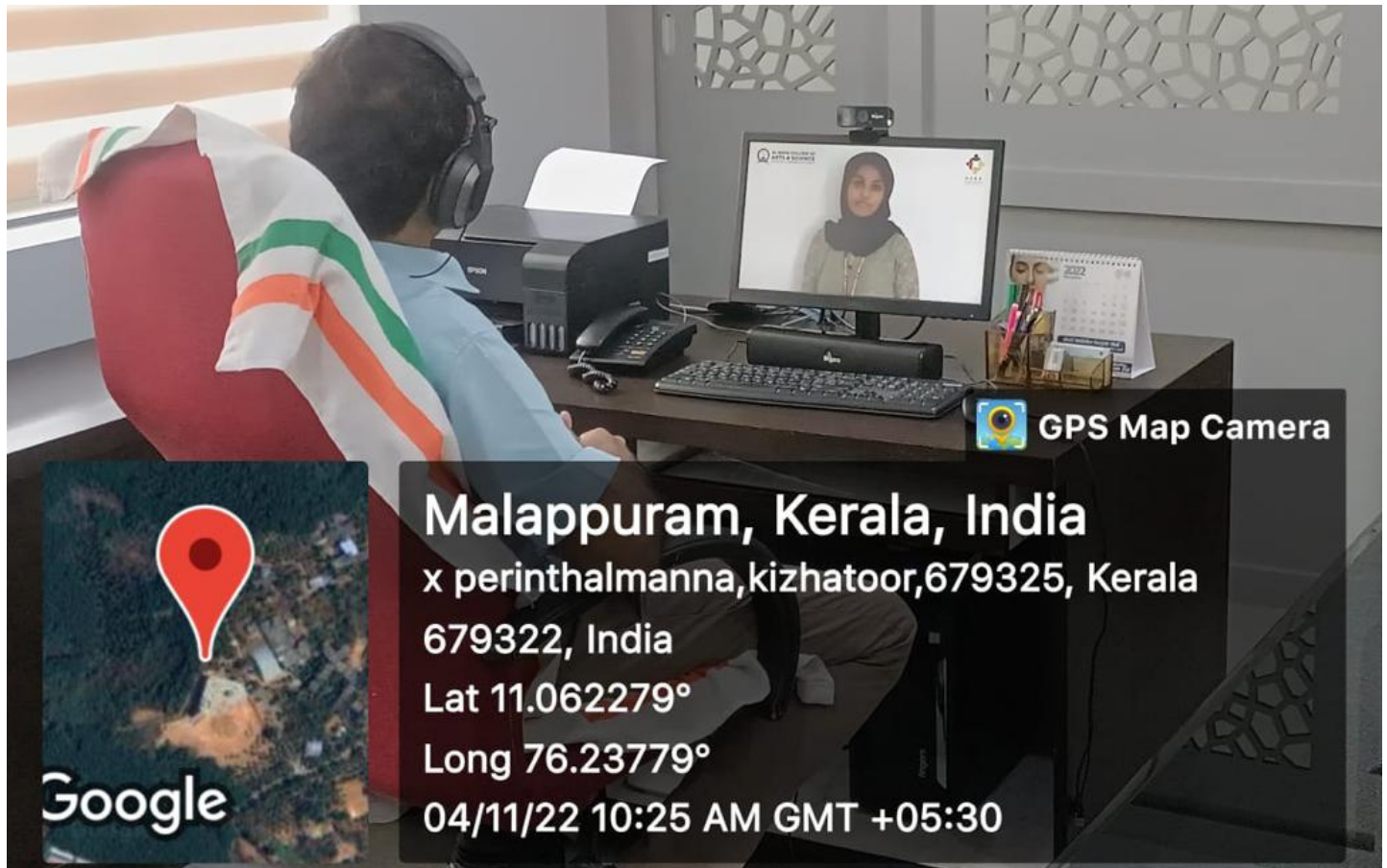

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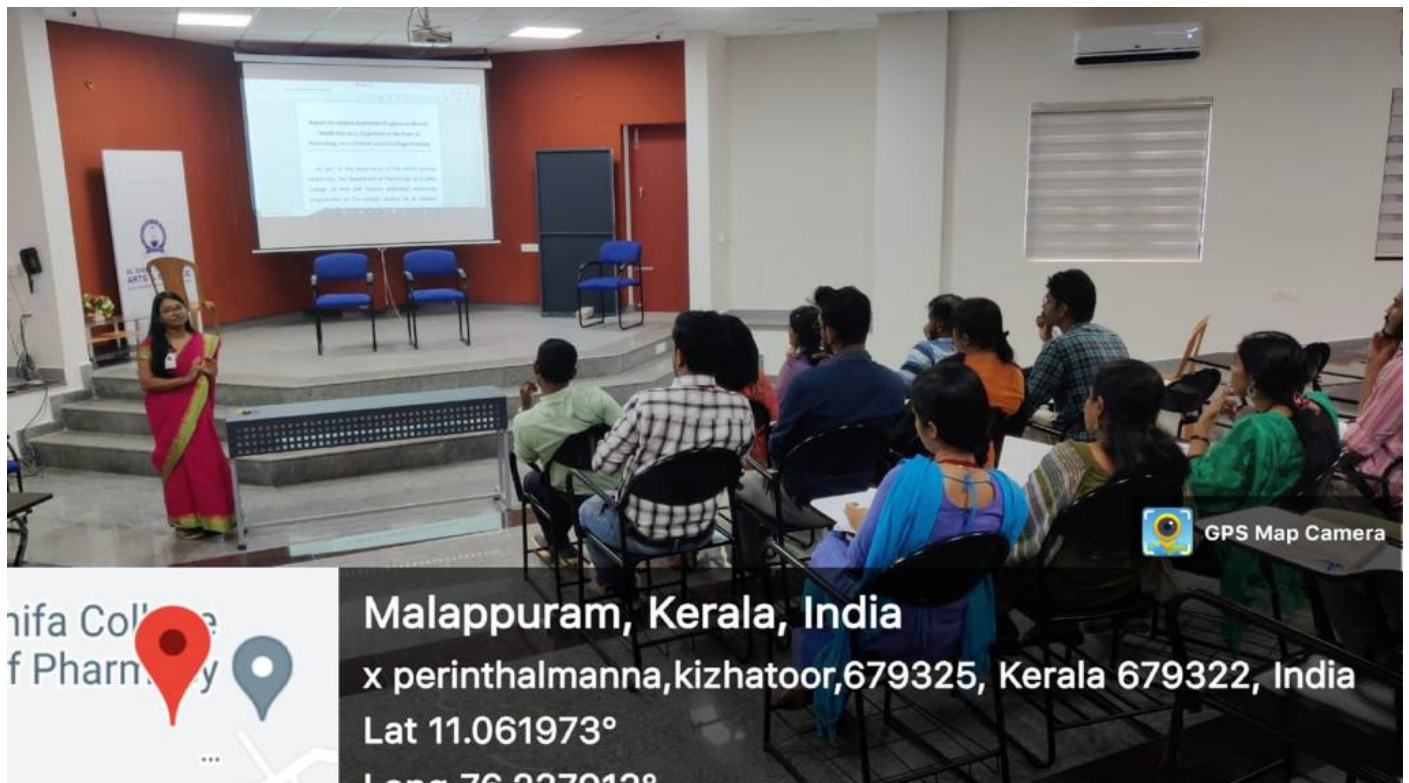
