Industry Visit to Elanad Milk Private Limited, Thrissur

As part of the BBA curriculum, the Second Semester BBA students of ACAS, undertook an industrial visit to Elanad Milk Private Limited, Thrissur on 9 January 2026. A total of 30 students of Second Semester BBA participated in the visit, accompanied by two faculty members, Ms. Rayhana K and Mr. Anas K, Assistant professors of the Department of Commerce and Management Studies. Prior to the factory visit, Mr. Jishnu, HR Associate, conducted an informative and interactive session for the students. He provided a detailed overview of the company, covering its history, growth, turnover, workforce, product range, organizational structure, and overall working system. The session gave students a clear understanding of the dairy industry and its operational framework. Following the introductory session, the students were taken for a guided factory visit, where they were introduced to the various stages of the manufacturing process. The visit included explanations on machinery usage, production flow, quality control measures, packaging processes, and other technical aspects of milk processing. After the completion of the industrial visit, the students proceeded to Kanthalloor, Idukki. The evening included a small campfire session and group discussion, which encouraged interaction, reflection, and bonding among the students and faculty. The day concluded with an overnight stay at the resort. On the second day, after breakfast, the group went for trekking, during which they visited around 13 scenic viewpoints, including a traditional jaggery manufacturing unit at Marayoor. This experience provided additional exposure to local industries and natural landscapes. The visit successfully met its academic objectives and proved to be both educational and enjoyable.

The fest aimed to nurture artistic talents, encourage creativity, and promote cultural harmony among students while providing a vibrant platform for expression and healthy competition. As per university arts norms, a formal organizing committee was constituted under the leadership of Principal Dr. Kamaludheen K. T., as Patron. To ensure smooth conduct, four coordinators from each academic year were selected and assigned specific responsibilities. Based on the cumulative points scored across all events, the First Years secured the first place with 98 points, followed by the Second Years in second place with 67 points, and the Third Years in third place with 60 points.





Quiz on Virginia Woolf

General Knowledge Quiz

In his presentation, the speaker critically examined Woolf's ideas on women's professional struggles, social conditioning, and the metaphor of the "Angel in the House," highlighting its relevance in both historical and contemporary contexts. The session effectively brought out Woolf's feminist perspective and encouraged students to reflect on the challenges faced by women writers and professionals.



Let's Talk: Premenstrual Syndrome



The PG Dept. of Psychology and Counselling Cell, ACAS, organised an awareness session titled “Let's Talk: Premenstrual Syndrome” on 19 January 2026 for the first year Psychology students. The session was handled by Ms. Fathimath Fahiza M.K, II Semester M.Sc. Clinical Psychology student. The session focused on creating awareness about Premenstrual Syndrome (PMS), including its psychological, emotional, and physiological aspects. The speaker explained common

symptoms, possible causes, and the impact of PMS on daily functioning and mental well-being. Emphasis was also given to coping strategies, self-care practices, and the importance of seeking professional support when required. The session encouraged open discussion. Participants actively engaged in the session.

An Invited Student Talk titled “Magnesium: Forgotten Mineral of Modern Health” was successfully conducted by the NutriNourish Club in collaboration with the Dept. of Nutrition and Dietetics, ACAS, on 22 January 2026. The session was delivered by Ms. Fathima Mehrin, II Year B.Voc. Nutrition Science and Dietetics student of MES Mampad College (Autonomous). The talk highlighted the physiological importance of magnesium, its role in metabolic functions, common causes of deficiency, dietary sources, and its relevance in the prevention of lifestyle disorders. A total of 33 students benefited from the programme, gaining enhanced awareness and practical knowledge regarding the significance of magnesium in modern health and nutrition.

Trade Talk - Interaction with the Student Traders of ACAS

The Trading Club of the Dept. of Commerce and Management Studies, ACAS, organised an interactive session titled “Trade Talk – Interaction with the Student Traders of ACAS” on 21 January 2026. The programme aimed to provide practical exposure to students by facilitating direct interaction with experienced student traders. The session created an engaging platform for sharing real-time trading experiences, market insights, and learning beyond textbooks. Dr. Shibla Sherin's Research Featured in International Journal

Dr. Shibla Sherin. P, Assistant Professor, Dept. of Commerce and Management Studies, ACAS, has published a research paper titled “Emotional Intelligence of Leaders and its Impact on Employee Engagement and Retention” in the International Research Journal of Education and Technology (Vol. 9, No. 1, January 2026, pp. 292–313). The research explores the significant role of emotional intelligence in effective leadership and examines how leaders’ emotional competencies influence employee engagement levels and organisational retention. The study highlights the growing importance of emotionally intelligent leadership in contemporary organisational settings and provides valuable insights for management professionals and academic researchers alike. This scholarly achievement reflects Dr. Shibla Sherin's continued commitment to research excellence and contributes meaningfully to the fields of leadership studies and human resource management.

Peer Teaching Session by the Department of Computer Science

A Peer-to-Peer Teaching Session was conducted for Second Semester BCA students on 21 January 2026, organised by the Dept. of Computer Science, ACAS. The session was handled by Noorsha (II Semester BCA) on the topic “Measures of Central Tendencies – Mean.” The presentation was clear, well-structured, and focused on explaining the concept of ‘Mean’ with simple examples, which helped the students understand the topic effectively.



IQ Assessment Camp held at Pratheeksha Buds School

The PG Dept. of Psychology, in collaboration with the Center for Psychometrics and the Mindlance Club of ACAS, organized an IQ Assessment Camp at Pratheeksha Buds School, Pandikkad, on 22 January 2026. The camp was conducted with the active involvement of 35 PG and UG students, and IQ assessment was carried out for a total of 45 participants. Well-established and standardized psychological assessment tools such as WAPIS, WISC, BKT, and VSMS were used to assess the intellectual abilities and social adaptive functioning of the clients. The IQ Assessment Camp provided students with a valuable opportunity to gain hands-on experience in administering psychological tests under supervised conditions. Through direct interaction with the participants, students were able to enhance their understanding of various mental health conditions and developmental concerns. The camp was organized to help students develop a clearer understanding of the roles and responsibilities of psychologists in educational and community settings. The experience contributed significantly to fostering empathy, social responsibility, and sensitivity toward individuals with diverse psychological and developmental needs. The programme emphasized the importance of professional ethics, discipline, and responsible practice in psychological assessment.



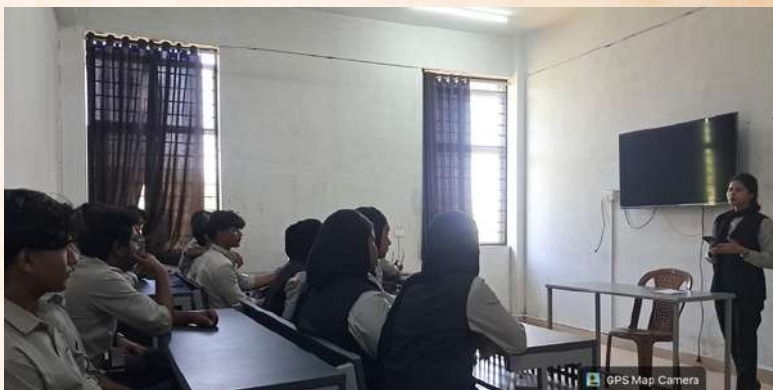
Shakespeare's Sister Speaks

The final session of the Virginia Woolf Week Observance was organized by the Dept. of English on 23 January 2026. The session marked the conclusion of the week-long literary programme organized by the department. Student presentations were held on the topic "Shakespeare's Sister Speaks" from *A Room of One's Own* by Virginia Woolf. The presentation was delivered by Ms. Fathima Sherin M. P and Ms. Mufeeda. P, Fourth Semester B. A. English Language and Literature. The presenters explored Woolf's feminist arguments and her critique of the marginalization of women in literary history. ഓരോ മേഖലയിലും ഓരോ രീതിയിലാണ് അമേരിക്കൻ ഇടപെടലുകൾ നമുക്ക് കാണാൻ കഴിയുക. ഉക്രൈൻ റഷ്യ യുദ്ധത്തിൽ ഉക്രൈൻ പിന്തുണ നൽകുകയും സാമ്പത്തികവും സൈനികവുമായ സഹായം നൽകിയതോടൊപ്പം മറ്റു പാശ്ചാത്യ രാജ്യങ്ങളുടെ പിന്തുണ കൂടി അവർക്ക് ഉറപ്പാക്കാനും അമേരിക്ക പരിശ്രമിച്ചിട്ടുണ്ട്.എന്നാൽ ബദ്ധവൈരിയായ റഷ്യയെ അസ്ഥിരപ്പെടുത്താനും തങ്ങളുടെ മാരകായുധങ്ങൾ പരീക്ഷിക്കുവാനുള്ള ഒരു അവസരമായുമാണ് ഈ യുദ്ധത്തെ അമേരിക്ക ഉപയോഗിച്ചത് എന്ന് ആർക്കും മനസ്സിലാക്കാൻ സാധിക്കും. ഒരു വേളയിൽ ഉക്രൈൻ പ്രസിഡണ്ട് വ്ലാദിമിർ സെലൻസ്കിയെ തളളിപ്പറഞ്ഞതും മാധ്യമങ്ങൾക്കു മുന്നിൽ അവഹേളിച്ചതും ഉക്രൈനോട് അമേരിക്കയ്ക്ക് തെല്ലും സഹതാപമില്ല എന്നതിന് തെളിവാണ്. റഷ്യ നടത്തിയത് അധിനിവേശമാണ് എന്ന് സഹതപിച്ച ഇതേ രാജ്യമാണ് വെനസ്വേലയെ ആക്രമിച്ച് പ്രസിഡൻറ് നിക്കോളാസ് മഡുറോയെയും കുടുംബത്തെയും അമേരിക്കയിലേക്ക് കടത്തിക്കൊണ്ടുപോയത്. ലഹരിക്കടത്ത് ആരോപിച്ചാണ് അമേരിക്ക വെനസ്വേലയെ ആക്രമിച്ചത്. എന്നാൽ ലോകത്തിലെ തന്നെ ഏറ്റവും വലിയ എണ്ണ ശേഖരം വെനസ്വേലയിലാണ് എന്നത് അമേരിക്കയുടെ ഉദ്ദേശശുദ്ധിയിലെ കാപട്യം തുറന്നുകാട്ടുന്നു. മുമ്പ് ഇറാഖിൽ അമേരിക്ക നടത്തിയ അധിനിവേശവും സമാനസാഹചര്യത്തിലായിരുന്നുവെന്ന് ചരിത്രം പരിശോധിച്ചാൽ മനസ്സിലാക്കാം.

അമേരിക്കയുടെ ഇന്ധന റിസർവ് കുറയുമ്പോഴൊക്കെ ഇന്ധന നിക്ഷേപമുള്ള ദുർബല രാജ്യങ്ങൾ അമേരിക്കയാൽ ആക്രമിക്കപ്പെടുന്നു എന്നത് അമേരിക്കയുടെ ക്രൂരമായ ഇരട്ടമുഖം വെളിവാക്കുന്നു. ‘ആണവ ശക്തിയല്ലാത്ത രാജ്യങ്ങളുടെ എണ്ണനിക്ഷേപം അമേരിക്കക്കുള്ളതാണ്’ എന്ന ഒരു അമേരിക്കൻ പ്രസിദ്ധീകരണത്തിലെ കാർട്ടൂൺ ഇതേ യാഥാർഥ്യമാണ് വരച്ചുകാട്ടുന്നത്.

അടുത്തതായി അമേരിക്ക ലക്ഷ്യം വെക്കുന്നത് ഡെന്മാർക്കിന്റെ ഭാഗമായ ഗ്രീൻലാൻഡിനെയാണ്. അമേരിക്കയെ സംബന്ധിച്ചിടത്തോളം അതീവ തന്ത്രപ്രധാന മേഖലയായാണ് ഗ്രീൻലാൻഡ് കണക്കാക്കപ്പെടുന്നത്. റഷ്യ,ചൈന,ഉത്തരകൊറിയ തുടങ്ങിയ ഏത് പ്രബല ശത്രുക്കളിൽ നിന്നും വരുന്ന ആക്രമണങ്ങൾ ഈ പ്രദേശത്ത് നിന്നും ഫലപ്രദമായി തടയാൻ കഴിയും എന്ന് അമേരിക്ക വിശ്വസിക്കുന്നു. തന്ത്രപ്രധാന മേഖല എന്നതിനപ്പുറം ധാരാളം അപൂർവ്വ ധാതുക്കളുടെ വൻനിക്ഷേപമുള്ള പ്രദേശം കൂടിയാണ് ഗ്രീൻലാൻഡ്. ഈ പ്രദേശം നിയന്ത്രണത്തിലായാൽ സ്മാർട്ട്ഫോൺ മുതൽ യുദ്ധവിമാനങ്ങൾ വരെ നിർമ്മിക്കാൻ ഉപയോഗിക്കുന്ന ഈ ധാതുസമ്പത്തും അമേരിക്കയുടേതായി മാറും. അമേരിക്ക എന്തിനാണ് ഗ്രീൻലാൻഡിൽ കണ്ണുവച്ചത് എന്ന് നമുക്ക് ഊഹിക്കാവുന്നതേ ഉള്ളൂ.

സാമ്പത്തിക വിദഗ്ദ്ധരുടെ വിലയിരുത്തൽ പ്രകാരം ഈയൊരു നൂറ്റാണ്ടിൽ ഏറ്റവുമധികം വളർച്ച കൈവരിക്കുക ഏഷ്യൻ രാജ്യങ്ങളാണ്. മുൻകാലങ്ങളിൽ ഈ നേട്ടം കൊയ്യാനായത് പാശ്ചാത്യ രാജ്യങ്ങൾക്കാണ്. ഈയൊരു മാറ്റം പാശ്ചാത്യ രാജ്യങ്ങളിൽ വലിയ രീതിയിലുള്ള ആശങ്ക ഉളവാക്കുന്നുണ്ട്. ഈ വളർച്ചയ്ക്ക് തടയിടാൻ പല തരത്തിലുള്ള ഇടപെടലുകൾ നടന്നുകൊണ്ടിരിക്കുകയാണ്. ഏഷ്യ നിരന്തരം അശാന്തമാവുന്നതിന്റെ പ്രധാനകാരണവും മേൽപറഞ്ഞതാണ്. ഏഷ്യയിലെ മിക്ക രാജ്യങ്ങളും വർഷങ്ങളായി ആഭ്യന്തര യുദ്ധങ്ങളിലോ അയൽ രാജ്യങ്ങളിൽ നിന്നുള്ള യുദ്ധ ഭീഷണിയിലോ ആണ്. ചൈനയെ താരിഫ് യുദ്ധത്തിൽ പരാജയപ്പെടുത്താനാണ് അമേരിക്ക ശ്രമിച്ചത് എന്നാൽ ചൈന തിരിച്ചടിച്ചതോടെ അമേരിക്ക പിന്മാറി. ചൈനയിലെ ഉത്പാദനത്തെ ആശ്രയിക്കാതെ അമേരിക്കൻ വിപണിക്ക് മുന്നോട്ടു പോകാൻ ആവില്ല എന്ന് ഭരണകൂടത്തിന് വ്യക്തമായി അറിയാം. ഇന്ത്യയ്ക്കെതിരായി ഒരു ഭാഗത്ത് താരിഫ് യുദ്ധവും മറുഭാഗത്ത് അയൽ രാജ്യങ്ങളിൽ നിന്നുള്ള യുദ്ധഭീഷണി വർദ്ധിപ്പിക്കാനും അമേരിക്ക ശ്രമിക്കുന്നു അമേരിക്കൻ പിന്തുണയുണ്ടെന്ന് തരത്തിലുള്ള സൈനിക മേധാവിയിരുടെ പ്രസ്താവന ഇതോടൊപ്പം കൂട്ടി വായിക്കണം. പശ്ചിമേഷ്യയിൽ ഇസ്രായേലിനുള്ള പിന്തുണ ദിനംപ്രതി വർദ്ധിപ്പിച്ചു കൊണ്ടിരിക്കുന്നു മുൻപ് നൽകിവന്നിരുന്ന സാമ്പത്തിക സഹായം 5 മടങ്ങാണ് വർദ്ധിപ്പിച്ചത്. അതുകൊണ്ടുതന്നെ സമീപ പ്രദേശങ്ങളിലെ എല്ലാ രാജ്യങ്ങളെയും ഇസ്രായേൽ ആക്രമിച്ചു. ചെറുത്ത് നിന്ന ഇറാനിൽ അതിപ്രഹര ശേഷിയുള്ള ബോംബുകളാണ് അമേരിക്ക വർഷിച്ചത്. ഇസ്രായേലിന് എതിരായി ഐക്യരാഷ്ട്രസഭയിൽ ഉയർന്നുവന്ന എല്ലാ പ്രമേയങ്ങളും അമേരിക്ക വിറ്റോ ചെയ്തു. പശ്ചിമേഷ്യയിൽ അമേരിക്കയുടെ ആധിപത്യം നിലനിർത്താൻ ഇസ്രായേലിനെ പിന്തുണക്കേണ്ടത് അനിവാര്യമാണ്. അതുകൊണ്ട് തന്നെ ഇസ്രായേൽ നടത്തുന്ന എല്ലാ അതിക്രമങ്ങൾക്കും നിഷ്ക്കരണം പിന്തുണ ഉറപ്പാക്കുകയാണ് അമേരിക്ക.

സമാധാന കക്ഷികൾ എന്ന മേലങ്കി സദാ അണിയുന്ന ഇവർ തന്നെയാണ് ലോകത്തിലേറ്റവും കൂടുതൽ യുദ്ധത്തിലേർപ്പെട്ടത്. ലോക നന്മ ഉറപ്പാക്കാൻ ശ്രമിക്കുന്നവരാണ് സ്വയം വിശേഷിപ്പിക്കുന്ന ഇവർ ലോകാരോഗ്യ സംഘടനയിൽ നിന്നും പിന്മാറുകയും ആരോഗ്യ മേഖലയ്ക്കായി നൽകി വന്നിരുന്ന എല്ലാവിധ സഹായങ്ങളും നിർത്തിവയ്ക്കുകയും ചെയ്തിട്ടുണ്ട്. ലോകസമാധാനം ഉറപ്പുവരുത്താൻ അമേരിക്കയുമായുള്ള സൈനിക സഖ്യത്തിൽ നിന്നും പിന്മാറാനും അമേരിക്കൻ ഡോളറിന് ശക്തമായ ഒരു ബദൽ കണ്ടെത്താനും ലോകരാജ്യങ്ങൾ ഒരുമിക്കേണ്ടതുണ്ട്. അമേരിക്കയുടെ സ്വാർത്ഥ താല്പര്യങ്ങളും നയങ്ങളും ഇത്രയേറെ പ്രകടമായിട്ടും അമേരിക്കയെ തിരുത്താനോ മാറ്റിനിർത്താനോ അന്താരാഷ്ട്ര തലത്തിൽ ഒരുതരത്തിലുള്ള സഖ്യങ്ങളോ സംഘടനകളും രൂപപ്പെടാത്തത് അത്യന്തം നിരാശാജനകമാണ്. തൽസ്ഥിതി തുടരുന്ന കാലമത്രയും അമേരിക്ക നടത്തുന്ന അധിനിവേശങ്ങളും ഏകപക്ഷീയമായ യുദ്ധങ്ങളും തുടരുക തന്നെ ചെയ്യും...



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ദൈവത്തിന്റെ സ്വന്തം നാട്, കേരളം പലകാര്യങ്ങളിലും ലോകത്തിന് മാതൃകയാണ്. സമ്പൂർണ്ണ സാക്ഷരത കൈവരിച്ച സംസ്ഥാനം, ഡിജിറ്റൽ സാക്ഷരത കൈവരിച്ച സംസ്ഥാനം, സർവ്വത്രിക വിദ്യാഭ്യാസം, പൊതുജനാരോഗ്യ സംവിധാനം, മാതൃ-ശിശു മരണ നിരക്കിലെ നേട്ടങ്ങൾ, അതി ദരിദ്ര നിർമ്മാജനം ഉൾപ്പെടെയുള്ള ക്ഷേമ പ്രവർത്തനങ്ങൾ, കോവിഡ് പരിചരണത്തിലെ ഇടപെടലുകൾ, ടൂറിസം, ശുചിത്വം തുടങ്ങി പലമേഖലകളിൽ കേരളം രാജ്യത്തിന് മാത്രമല്ല ലോകത്തിന് തന്നെ മാതൃകയായിട്ടുണ്ട്. വയനാട് ഉരുൾപൊട്ടൽ ദുരിത ബാധിതർക്ക് കല്പന ടൗണിനോട് ചേർന്ന് നിർമ്മിക്കുന്ന ടൗൺ ഷിപ്പ് പ്രവർത്തിയിലൂടെ ദുരന്തപുനരടിവാസത്തിലും കേരളം ലോകത്തിന് മാതൃക സൃഷ്ടിക്കുകയാണ്.

2024 ജൂലൈ 30 നാണ് വയനാട് ജില്ലയിലെ മേപ്പാടി പഞ്ചായത്തിലെ മുണ്ടക്കൈ, ചുരൽമല, അട്ടമല, പുഞ്ചിരിമറ്റം തുടങ്ങിയ പ്രദേശങ്ങളെ തകർത്ത ഉരുൾപൊട്ടൽ ഉണ്ടായത്. ഒരൊറ്റ രാത്രി കൊണ്ട് പ്രദേശം ഒലിച്ചു പോയി. 400 ൽ അധികം പേർ മരണപ്പെട്ടു. അത്രത്തോൾ പേർക്ക് വലിയ പരിക്കേറ്റു. മരണപ്പെട്ട പലരുടെയും മൃതദേഹങ്ങൾ പോലും കണ്ടെടുക്കാൻ സാധിച്ചില്ല. മൃതദേഹങ്ങളും ശരീര ഭാഗങ്ങളും കിലോ മീറ്ററുകൾ ഒഴുകി മലപ്പുറം ജില്ലയിലെ നിലമ്പൂർ ഭാഗത്ത് നിന്നാണ് ലഭിച്ചത്. ഡി എൻ എ ടെസ്റ്റ് നടത്തിയാണ് മൃതദേഹങ്ങൾ പലതും തിരിച്ചറിഞ്ഞത്. നിരവധി ജീവനുകളോടൊപ്പം പ്രകൃതി സുന്ദരമായ ഒരു നാട് തന്നെ ഇല്ലാതെയായി. ഒരു സ്കൂളും നിരവധി സ്ഥാപനങ്ങളും ഒരു ജനതയുടെ അത്രയും കാലത്തെ സമ്പാദ്യം മുഴുവനായും ആ രാത്രി ഇല്ലാതെയായി. രക്ഷാ പ്രവർത്തനത്തിലെ പൊതുജന പങ്കാളിത്തവും കേരള മാതൃകയായി. തിരിച്ചറിയാത്ത മൃതദേഹങ്ങൾ സർവ്വ മത പ്രാർത്ഥനയോടെ സംസ്കരിച്ചു. സമീപ കാലത്ത് കേരളത്തിൽ നടന്ന ഓവി ചുഴലിക്കാറ്റ്, രണ്ട് പ്രളയങ്ങൾ, ലോകം വിറച്ച കോവിഡ് മഹാമാരി തുടങ്ങിയ ദുരന്ത സമയങ്ങളിൽ എന്ന പോലെ ഈ ദുരന്തത്തെയും നേരിടാൻ കേരളം ഒറ്റക്കെട്ടായി മുന്നോട്ട് വന്നു. രാജ്യത്തെ സൈന്യം ഉൾപ്പെടെ എല്ലാ സംവിധാനങ്ങളും രക്ഷപ്രവർത്തനത്തിൽ സജീവമായി പങ്കെടുത്തു.

ദുരിതശ്വാസ പ്രവർത്തനങ്ങൾക്ക് ശേഷം പുനരധിവാസ പ്രവർത്തനങ്ങളിലേക്ക് നാട് നീങ്ങി. സകലതും നഷ്ടപ്പെട്ട ഒരു നാടിനെ വീണ്ടെടുക്കുക, ദുരിതബാധിതരുടെ ജീവിതം തിരിച്ചു പിടിക്കുക എന്നതായിരുന്നു ലക്ഷ്യം. ഈ നാടിനെ വീണ്ടെടുക്കാൻ മുഖ്യമന്ത്രിയുടെ ദുരിതാശ്വാസ നിധിയിലേക്ക് ജനങ്ങൾ ഉദാരമായി സംഭാവന ചെയ്തു. വ്യവസായികൾ, പ്രവാസികൾ, വിവിധ സംഘടനകൾ, സാധാരണക്കാരായ ജനങ്ങൾ, കുട്ടികൾ, വിദ്യാർത്ഥികൾ തുടങ്ങി എല്ലാ വിഭാഗം ജനങ്ങളും ഇതിന്റെ ഭാഗമായി. മറ്റു സംസ്ഥാനങ്ങളിൽ നിന്നും വിദേശ രാജ്യങ്ങളിൽ നിന്നും കേരളത്തിനുള്ള സ്നേഹമായി ദുരിതശ്വാസ നിധിയിലേക്ക് ജനങ്ങൾ സംഭാവന നൽകി. ദുരിതബാധിതർക്ക് ചികിത്സയും ഭക്ഷണവും താൽക്കാലിക താമസവും ഒരുക്കുന്നതിനോടൊപ്പം ആ ഗ്രാമത്തെ തന്നെ വീണ്ടെടുക്കുക എന്നതായിരുന്നു പ്രധാനം.

പുനരധിവാസം എങ്ങനെ ആവണം എന്നതിനെ കുറിച്ച് പല ചർച്ചകളും നടന്നു. പല അഭിപ്രായങ്ങളും ഉയർന്നു വന്നു. സർക്കാർ ടൗൺഷിപ്പ് എന്ന തീരുമാനത്തിൽ എത്തി. ഉരുൾ എടുത്ത ഗ്രാമത്തെ മറ്റൊരിടത്ത് പുനർ നിർമ്മിക്കലായിരുന്നു ടൗൺഷിപ്പിന്റെ ലക്ഷ്യം. ദുരിതബാധിതർക്ക് 1000 സ്ക്വയർ ഫീറ്റ് വീടും ടൗൺഷിപ്പിന്റെ ഭാഗമായി കളിസ്ഥലവും അങ്കണവാടിയും പൊതു മാർക്കറ്റും ആശുപത്രിയും കമ്മ്യൂണിറ്റി സെന്ററും, ലൈബ്രറിയും എല്ലാ സൗകര്യവും ഉൾപ്പെടുന്നു. ടൗൺഷിപ്പിൽ വീട് വേണ്ടാത്തവർക്ക് 15 ലക്ഷം രൂപ നൽകുകയും ചെയ്തു. 410 കുടുംബങ്ങൾ ടൗൺഷിപ്പിന്റെ ഭാഗമാകാൻ തീരുമാനിച്ചു. ഇത്രയും വീടും മറ്റു സൗകര്യങ്ങളും ഒരുക്കാനുള്ള സ്ഥലം കണ്ടെത്തുക എന്നതായിരുന്നു അടുത്ത കടമ്പ. അതിനായി സർക്കാർ രണ്ട് സ്ഥലങ്ങൾ കണ്ടെത്തി. കല്പറ്റ ടൗണിനോട് ചേർന്ന എൽസ്സൺ എസ്റ്റേറ്റ് അതിനായി സർക്കാർ തെരഞ്ഞെടുത്തു. പണം നൽകി ഭൂമി ഏറ്റെടുക്കാൻ സർക്കാർ തീരുമാനിച്ചു. എന്നാൽ എസ്റ്റേറ്റ് ഉടമകൾ ഇതിനെതിരെ കോടതിയെ സമീപിച്ചു. ഇത് ടൗൺഷിപ്പ് പ്രവർത്തികൾ ആരംഭിക്കുന്നതിൽ കാലതാമസം ഉണ്ടാക്കി. സർക്കാർ തീരുമാനം ബഹുമാനപ്പെട്ട കേരള ഹൈകോടതി അംഗീകരിക്കുകയും ചെയ്തു. കോടതി വിധി വന്നതോടെ സർക്കാർ സ്ഥലം ഏറ്റെടുത്ത് പ്രവർത്തികൾ തുടക്കം കുറിച്ചു.

ദുരന്തത്തിൽ വീട് നഷ്ടപ്പെട്ടവർക്ക് പുനരധിവാസ പ്രവർത്തനങ്ങളുടെ ഭാഗമായാണ് കല്പറ്റ ബൈപാസിൽ സർക്കാർ ഏറ്റെടുത്ത എൽസ്സൺ എസ്റ്റേറ്റിന്റെ 64 ഹെക്ടർ ഭൂമിയിൽ ലോകത്തിന് മാതൃകയായ വയനാട് ടൗൺഷിപ്പ് ഉയരുന്നത്. ദുരിത ബാധിതർക്ക് ഒരേ സ്ഥലത്ത് ഗുണനിലവാരമുള്ള പുനധിവാസം ഇവിടെ സർക്കാർ ഉറപ്പാക്കുന്നു. 5 സോണുകളിലായി 410 വീടുകളാണ് ടൗൺഷിപ്പിന്റെ ഭാഗമായി ഉയരുന്നത്. കിഫ്ബി യുടെ കൺസൾട്ടൻസി വിഭാഗമായ കിഫ്കോണിന്റെ മേൽനോട്ടത്തിൽ ഊരാലുങ്കൽ ലേബർ കോൺട്രാക്ട് സൊസൈറ്റിയാണ് നിർമ്മാണ പ്രവർത്തികൾ നടത്തുന്നത്. നിർമ്മാണവും മേൽനോട്ടവും രണ്ട് ഏജൻസികൾ ചെയ്യണം എന്ന സർക്കാർ തീരുമാന പ്രകാരമാണ് കിഫ്കോണിനെയും ഊരാലുങ്കൽ സൊസൈറ്റിയെയും എല്ലിച്ചത്. 7 സെന്റ് ഭൂമിയിൽ 1000 സ്ക്വയർ ഫീറ്റ് വീടുകൾ ആണ് നിർമ്മിക്കുന്നത്. ഇനി ഒരു പ്രകൃതി ദുരന്തം ഉണ്ടായാൽ അതിജീവിക്കാൻ കഴിയുന്ന നൂതന ടെക്നോളജി (സെസ്മിക് റെസിസ്റ്റൻസ് ടെക്നോളജി) ഉപയോഗിച്ചാണ് വീടുകളുടെ നിർമ്മാണം നടത്തുന്നത്. 35 ക്ലസ്റ്ററുകളിലായി നിർമ്മാണം പുരോഗമിക്കുന്ന ടൗൺഷിപ്പിൽ ഓരോ ക്ലസ്റ്ററിലും കുട്ടികൾക്ക് കളിക്കുന്നതിനും മുതിർന്നവർക്ക് ഒത്തുകൂടാനുമുള്ള പൊതു ഇടങ്ങളുണ്ട്. മാതൃക വീട് നിർമ്മിച്ച് ഗുണഭോക്താക്കളെ ഗുണനിലവാരം ബോധ്യപ്പെടുത്തി അവരുടെ അഭിപ്രായങ്ങൾ കൂടി പരിഗണിച്ചാണ് ആവശ്യമെങ്കിൽ മാറ്റങ്ങൾ വരുത്തിയാണ് ടൗൺഷിപ്പിലെ വീടുകളുടെ നിർമ്മാണം നടത്തുന്നത്. വീട് നിർമ്മാണത്തിലും വയറിംഗ്, പ്ലബ്ബിങ്, ബാത്റൂം ഫിറ്റിംഗ്സ് തുടങ്ങി എല്ലാ കാര്യത്തിലും മികച്ച നിലവാരമുള്ളവയാണ് ഉപയോഗിച്ചിട്ടുള്ളത്. 20 വർഷത്തോളം വാറന്റിയുള്ള വിപണിയിൽ ലഭ്യമായ ഏറ്റവും മികച്ച സാധന സാമഗ്രികളാണ് നിർമ്മാണത്തിൽ ഉപയോഗിക്കുന്നത്. സിമന്റ്, മണൽ, മെറ്റൽ, കമ്പി മുതലായവ ലാബിൽ പരിശോധന നടത്തി ഗുണമേന്മ ഉറപ്പാവരുത്തിയാണ് ഉപയോഗിക്കുന്നത്. മുഴുവൻ നിർമ്മാണങ്ങൾക്കും 5 വർഷത്തേക്ക് കേടുപാടുകളിൽ നിന്നും കരാറുകാരൻ സംരക്ഷണം നൽകും. മൂന്നുറോളം വീടുകളുടെ മെയിൻ വാർപ്പ് പ്രവർത്തി പൂർത്തീകരിച്ചു.

ആദ്യഘട്ട വീടുകൾ 2026 ഫെബ്രുവരി മാസത്തോടെ കൈമാറാൻ സാധിക്കും എന്നാണ് പ്രതീക്ഷിക്കുന്നത്.

മുഖ്യമന്ത്രിയുടെ ന്യൂ ഇയർ ആശംസ സന്ദേശത്തിൽ വയനാട് ടൗൺഷിപ്പിന്റെ ആദ്യ ഘട്ട വീടുകൾ ഫെബ്രുവരി മാസത്തിൽ നൽകാൻ സാധിക്കും എന്ന് അറിയിച്ചിട്ടുണ്ട്. നിലവിൽ 1500 ലധികം തൊഴിലാളികൾ ഷിഫ്റ്റ് അടിസ്ഥാനത്തിൽ 24 മണിക്കൂറും ജോലി ചെയ്ത് വരുന്നു.

സമയബന്ധിതമായി വർക്ക് പൂർത്തീകരിക്കാനുള്ള ശ്രമമാണ് നടന്നുകൊണ്ടിരിക്കുന്നത്. വയനാട് ടൗൺഷിപ്പിൽ കേവലം വീടുകൾ മാത്രമല്ല ഉയരുന്നത്. ടൗൺഷിപ്പിലെ താമസക്കാർക്ക് ആവശ്യമായ കുടുംബ ആരോഗ്യ കേന്ദ്രം, അങ്കണവാടി, പൊതുമർക്കറ്റ്, കളിസ്ഥലം, കമ്മ്യൂണിറ്റി സെന്റർ, മൾട്ടി പർപ്പസ് ഹാൾ, ലൈബ്രറി തുടങ്ങിയവയും ടൗൺഷിപ്പിന്റെ ഭാഗമായി വരുന്നു. ടൗൺഷിപ്പിൽ 11.4 കിലോ മീറ്റർ റോഡ് നിർമ്മാണം പൂർത്തിയായി വരുന്നു. ടൗൺഷിപ്പിലെ റോഡ് നിർമ്മാണ പ്രവർത്തനങ്ങൾ ദ്രുതഗതിയിൽ പുരോഗമിക്കുകയാണ്. മൂന്ന് ഘട്ടങ്ങളായാണ് റോഡ് നിർമ്മാണം പുരോഗമിക്കുന്നത്. 12.65 മീറ്റർ വീതിയിലുള്ള പ്രധാന പാത 1100 മീറ്റർ ഉണ്ട്. 9.5 മീറ്റർ വീതിയിൽ നിർമ്മിക്കുന്ന റോഡ് 2.7 കിലോ മീറ്ററും ഉണ്ടാവും. ഇടറോഡുകളായി കണക്കാക്കുന്ന 5.8 മീറ്റർ വീതിയിൽ നിർമ്മിക്കുന്ന 7.5 കിലോ മീറ്റർ റോഡും ഉണ്ട്. പ്രധാന റോഡിൽ ഇലക്ട്രിക്കൽ ഡക്ടും സൈഡ് ഡ്രൈനും ഉണ്ടാവും, അതിന്റെ നിർമ്മാണവും പുരോഗമിക്കുന്നു. ഒൻപത് ലക്ഷം ലിറ്റർ സംഭരണ ശേഷിയുള്ള കുറ്റൻ കുടിവെള്ള ടാങ്ക് ടൗൺഷിപ്പിന്റെ ഭാഗമായി നിർമ്മിക്കുന്നു. ഓരോ വീട്ടിലും 1000 ലിറ്റർ ശേഷിയുള്ള കുടിവെള്ള ടാങ്ക് ടൗൺഷിപ്പിന്റെ ഭാഗമായി വരുന്നു. സീവേജ് ട്രീറ്റ്മെന്റ് പ്ലാന്റ്, ഡ്രൈനേജ് എന്നിവയുടെ പ്രവർത്തനവും പുരോഗമിക്കുന്നു. സാദാഭരണ വൈദ്യുതി ലൈനുകൾക്ക് പകരം ഭൂഗർഭ വൈദ്യുതി കേബിളുകളാണ് ടൗൺഷിപ്പിൽ ഉപയോഗിച്ചിട്ടുള്ളത്. കെ എസ് ഇ ബി യുടെ 110 കെ വി ലൈനിനായി നാല് പ്രധാന ടവറുകൾ ടൗൺഷിപ്പിൽ സ്ഥാപിക്കുകയും ചെയ്തു. ഓരോ വീട്ടിലും സൗരരജ്യ പ്ലാന്റ് കുടി സ്ഥാപിക്കാൻ ലക്ഷ്യമിടുന്നു.

വയനാട് ടൗൺഷിപ്പ് പൂർത്തിയാകുന്നതോടെ പുനരധിവാസ പ്രവർത്തനങ്ങളിൽ ലോകത്തിന് കേരളം മാതൃകയാവും. കേരള മോഡൽ ഒരിക്കൽ കുടി ലോകത്തിന് മുന്നിൽ അവതരിപ്പിക്കപ്പെടും. ഭൂമി ഏറ്റെടുക്കൽ നിയമവ്യവഹാരത്തിൽ പെട്ടില്ലായിരുന്നെങ്കിൽ പുനരധിവാസ തീരുമാനം കുറെക്കൂടി നേരത്തേ പൂർത്തിയാകുമായിരുന്നു.



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
